## NAMI \& Ipsos conducted a new poll to check-in with the American public after one year of 988.

## KEY FINDINGS FROM OUR SUMMER 2023 POLL

Half of Americans say that funding for 988 should be a high or the highest priority for Congress.

An overwhelming majority of Americans 17\% are still NOT familiar with 988.

- Only $17 \%$ of people are familiar with 988.
- Only $4 \%$ say they are very familiar with 988.

People want a mental health response to someone experiencing a mental health or suicide crisis, not a police response.

3 in 5 Americans say they would be afraid the police may hurt them or their loved one while responding to a mental health crisis.

- This is higher for Black (77\%), Hispanic (75\%) and LGBTQ+(78\%) Americans.

A large majority agrees that young people need more mental health resources dedicated to them and their unique needs.

9 in 10 Americans support creating 24/7 mental health, alcohol/drug, and suicide crisis call centers that can respond effectively to callers and follow-up later.
