

Frequently Asked Questions: NAMI Creativity Survey for Youth-Engaged Individuals

Thank you for your interest in participating in this survey. NAMI is working with an industry partner to better understand how adults who engage directly with youth perceive the role of creative activities in the lives of youth. We are looking for youth-engaged adults to participate in an anonymous survey to inform our partner's future work. If you have further questions, feel free to contact us at researchstudy@nami.org.

1. What is the survey about?

This survey asks individuals who engage directly with young people about their perceptions of creative activities for youth. The survey includes questions about impacts of creative activities, barriers to access, and more. The survey will take approximately 15-20 minutes to complete.

2. Who is eligible to participate in the survey?

People who are 18 years of age or older, are residents of the United States, and work **directly** with youth and young adults (ages 13-25) through a paid job or unpaid volunteer or community position are eligible to participate in the survey. Examples include but are not limited to: educators, mentors, community organization volunteers (ex: Girl Scouts, Boys and Girls Clubs), faith organization staff/volunteers, and coaches.

To participate, you will need access to the Internet through a computer, tablet, or smartphone.

3. When will the survey be open?

The survey will open on Monday, July 31st and remain open until 11:59 PM EST on Friday, August 18th. You can only complete the survey once.

4. Are my responses confidential?

Yes. NAMI is not collecting names or contact information on this survey. Your personal information will not be associated with your answers.

5. What will be done with my responses?

Your responses will be stored on NAMI's database which follows industry confidentiality and ethical guidelines. All responses will be summarized and findings will be shared with NAMI's partner. The summarized findings may be used to create external media.

6. Is there compensation for completing the survey?
